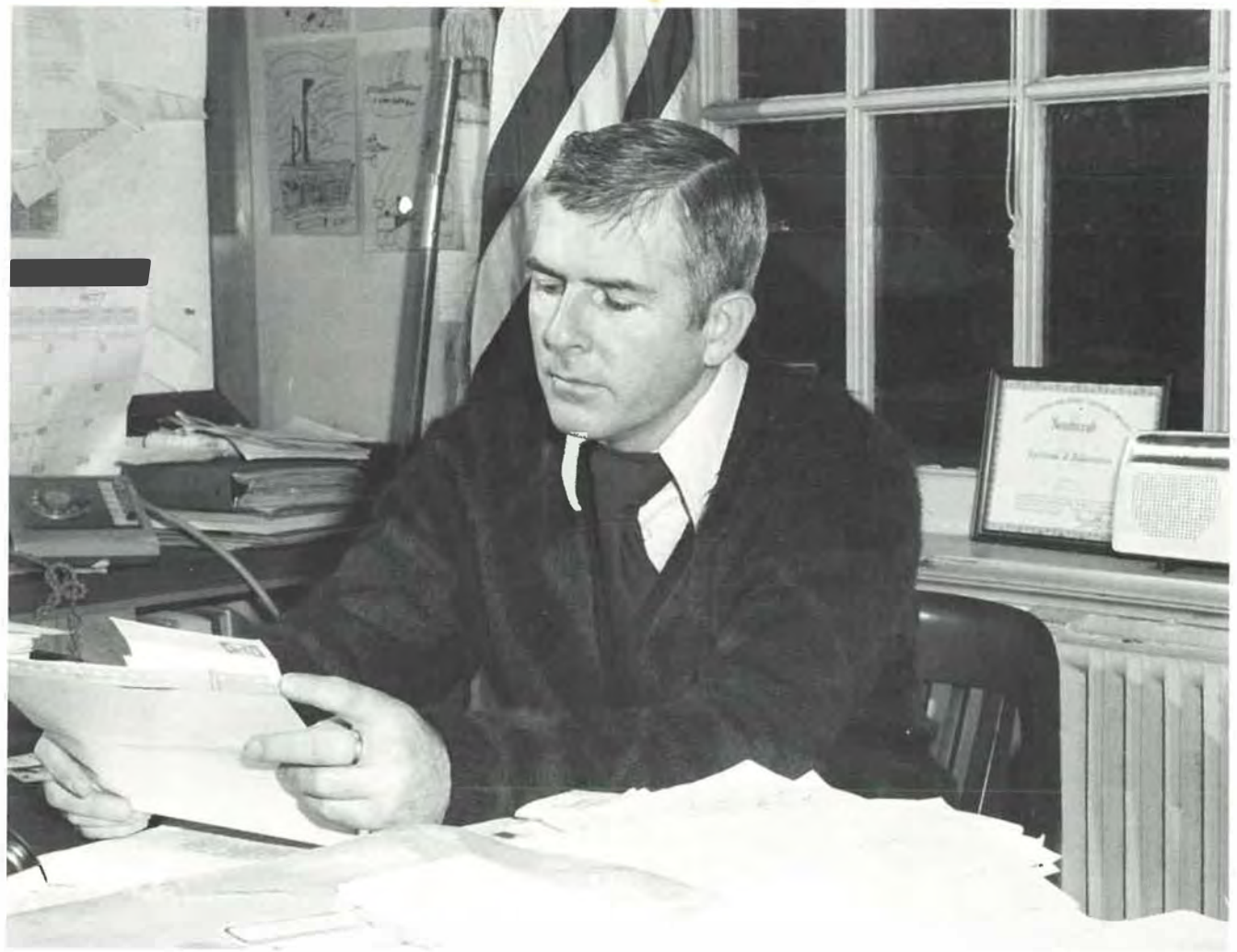

The distinguished reality of "friendship" is that you will be extremely fortunate to count yourself blessed if you can claim one other as an actual friend in a lifetime.

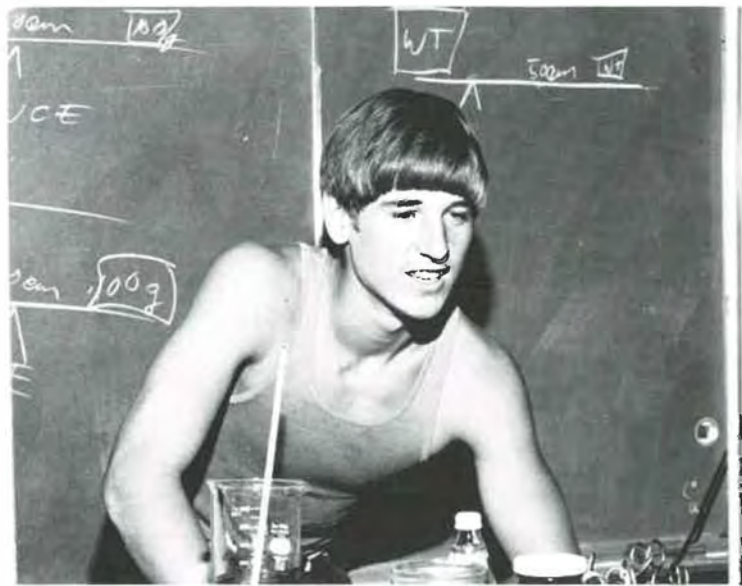
You do, however, carry the worlds greatest friend with you always - yourself.
